Because of its unique characteristics, a glaze finish is quite different from other cabinetry finishes you may be familiar with. It is important to realize that the designer look of glazing is achieved through a special process. We begin with the application of a toner for base color and to enhance the natural markings of the wood. The glaze is applied and then hand-wiped off, resulting in unique variances in coverage.

Because the glaze is individually applied and then removed by hand, the color saturation ranges from even and consistent to varied and dramatic. The hand removal of the glaze also produces a characteristic called "hang", where the excess glaze settles in the grooves and corners. The result is a one-of-a-kind look with the characteristics that make glazing so desirable.
